

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
THE JUDGE OF FULTON COUNTY,
ARKANSAS, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION
TO THE ARKANSAS ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION
FOR A CORONAVIRUS RELATED PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Fulton County is applying to the State of Arkansas for a Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus project through the Arkansas Economic Development Commission (AEDC). The grant will be used for the purchase of equipment for Fulton County Hospital; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that certain conditions be met as part of the application requirements; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County has conducted the required public hearing and has an active Citizens Participation Plan/Community Development Plan, and as part of the application process has received comments on community development and housing needs, and proposed activities; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Community Development Planning activities, Fulton County has identified and prioritized the community development and housing needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FULTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

The Judge is hereby authorized, on behalf of Fulton County, to submit an application to the State of Arkansas, for grant funds, under the Community Development provisions of the Coronavirus Prevention, Preparation and Response program, and to expend funds to accomplish such community development activities, if the grant is awarded.
