## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-

WHEREAS, members of the Quorum Court of Fulton County, Arkansas have taken an oath to support the Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution of Arkansas, and

WHEREAS, members of the Quorum Court of Fulton County, Arkansas recognize the rights guaranteed to United States citizens under the second amendment to the United States Constitution, and

WHEREAS, members of the Quorum Court of Fulton County, Arkansas recognize that powers and responsibilities enumerated in the Constitution of the United States that are not specifically given to the Federal Government are reserved and protected for the individuals and respective state governments by the ninth and tenth amendments to the United States Constitution, and

WHEREAS, members of the Quorum Court of Fulton County, Arkansas recognize the responsibility of the state legislature to create laws to regulate the citizens of the state, and

WHEREAS, the current state legislature is considering laws to define powers of federal and state governments (including interstate and intrastate commerce and regulation powers (SB59) and clarify powers reserved for the state and rights reserved for the citizens in relation to the Constitution and the Second Amendment (HB1435)).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FULTON COUNTY ARKANSAS TO SUPPORT EFFORTS BY THE STATE LEGISATURE TO DEFINE, PRESERVE AND PROTECT THE INDIVIDUAL AND STATE RIGHTS AS FULLY AND CLEARLY AS POSSIBLE WITHIN THE BOUNDARY OF THE ARKANSAS AND UNITED STATES CONSTITUTIONS.
