A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CURRENT JUDGE AND TREASURER TO SET ASIDE MONEY FROM THE CURRENT AMERICAN RESCUE ACT FUND SURPLUS AND ESTABLISH A FUND DEDICATED TO THE RESTORATION AND REPAIR OF THE EXISTING FULTON COUNTY COURTHOUSE AND THE MAMMOTH SPRING VFW BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the existing Fulton County Courthouse has leaks in the roof and resulting interior damage; and

WHEREAS the damage is a threat to the structural integrity of the first floor of the building and a health risk for those working there; and

WHEREAS, the existing Mammoth Spring VFW Building has leaks and is in a general state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS the damage is a threat to the structural integrity of the building and a health risk to those utilizing the building; and

WHEREAS. County funds have not existed the repair the structures recently; and

WHEREAS. The previous work was underfunded and ineffective.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FULTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the Judge and treasurer work together to set aside a portion of the remaining American Rescue Act Funds, equal to the following: [a] \$500,000.00 for the Fulton County Courthouse repairs.

[b] \$50,000.00 for the Mammoth Spring VFW repairs.

SECTION 2: For the sole use of restoration, repair, and improvement on the existing Fulton County Court house on the Salem Court Square and the Mammoth Spring VFW building at Mammoth Spring, AR 72554.

SECTION 3: That upon completion of the work and payment of all bills and obligations, any remaining funds may be dispersed to groups requesting money to be used in accordance with the goals of the American Rescue Guidelines.


SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
