BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF THE COUNTY OF FULTON, STATE OF ARKANSAS, AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FEE TO BE COLLECTED FOR INSUFFICIENT CHECKS RECEIVED BY FULTON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, ACA §4-60-103,(a), Liability for Restitution, states that: "A person who issues a check that is not paid because the check was written on an account with insufficient funds has fifteen(15) days following the date of a written demand mailed or delivered to the drawer of the check at the address shown on the check or his or her last known address to pay to the holder of the check or his or her agent toe amount of the check and a collection fee not to exceed thirty dollars(\$30.00), plus the amount of any fees charges to the holder of the check by a financial institution as a result of the check's not being honored."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF FULTON COUNTY, ARKANSAS THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> It has been determined that it is in the best interest of the County to establish a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for all insufficient checks received by Fulton County, and that the collected fees will be deposited into the Fulton County General Fund.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Ordinance shall be codified in the Fulton County Code of Ordinances, and the sections may be re-numbered and re-lettered to accomplish such intention.
